### Trail Information



#### Lochan Tòrr an Tuill Trail ●●●

Climb steeply on the rocky shoulder of Spital of Boleskine for magnificent views of the ancient fort on Dun Dearduil, before continuing on to the beautiful Lochan Tòrr an Tuill.

Section of rough and narrow earth path with muddy and rocky parts. Long steep slopes for up to half a mile.

#### How to get here

Farigaig Forest is on the south side of Loch Ness, beside the B852 near Inverfarigaig.

From Inverness, take the B862 to Dores and then the B852 to Inverfarigaig. From Fort Augustus, take the B862 to Whitebridge and then the B852 via Foyers to reach Inverfarigaig.

At Inverfarigaig, look for the turning to Errogie, also marked with Forestry and Land Scotland signs to Farigaig. The car park is about 100 yards (100 metres) up this road on the right hand side.
